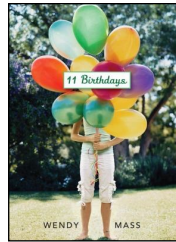
Kids Book Club

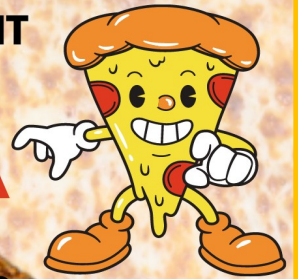
Bring Your Child to RPL Feb. 5
